Yes, if the partnership team is to continue and not fold
There was a variety of people and information from lots of different agencies
A wasted opportunity of a good idea
These forums are important for building public support in community safety. I fear, though, that those who attend are not necessarily the ones who should attend.
Excellent organisation, great foyer exhibition, Sally Taylor excellent, good sound system, need to do it annually or bi-annually
Yes, but only if the “partnership” id real. You need to work together and be seen to work together. From my own experience I have been sent from one department to another – both within the council offices, and the police & community police.

More question time please

More time to talk to panel – less films
Opening doors earlier as we arrived
Induction loop seemed not to be working – test all systems before commencement of event
More time for discussion
No – very well done

Good quality of films a little lacking in clarity. Otherwise first class event
More ventilation, more publicity – radio, local TV etc, more comfortable chairs – I now have backache!
Yes, I think if it was publicised better there would be an improvement in representation of the community. It would be interesting to have some kind of controlled debate. Would be interesting also to hear from youths or ex-offenders. Felt the atmosphere was punitive.
Try to make it more representative of the community. If I had not heard of this event through a friend, I would never have known it was taking place. One more thing – a less punitive judge would be nice!!
Less homilies and more productive factual answers needed
No mention was made of drug misuse. Are you really saying that drug misuse does not play any part in crime in Gosport? Is alcohol a bigger problem? (Am referring to the videos and voting section)
Any ‘success’ ought to be measured on what happens next? If nothing then the event could not be regarded as any great success.
Some answers to questions were facile and seem to ignore the real meaning of the question – too many ‘politician’ answers
Ladies with clipboards collecting questions – could do it by taking people to one side as to not inconvenience other people trying to listen to the presentations/speakers. Some people got a little upset!
Too hot!
The questions were poorly worded i.e. two questions in one (i.e. the Neighbourhood Watch question) – get them worded professionally – I can help!
Some poorly worded questions
No improvements, it was a superb meeting, hope it will be reproduced
Not really, but thanks.
More time should be allocated to the questions collected. Would have been nice to know how long the evening would last!

Not enough time spent on questions and could have opened up to controlled discussion.
Prime panel in advance of specific film subjects so statistics available
Some panel members could be better prepared. Strange smell in the hall.
More specific questions i.e. time of day visiting an area!?!
Question time – more info required regarding successes of work carried out i.e. engage youth – reduction in crime, role models within staff groups – mentor youngsters who may not have “acceptable role models” in the home.
