Urban drug networks do not care how much suffering or damage they inflict on people's lives.

These criminals sometimes take over the homes of victims (known as cuckooing).

## Some of the signs to look out for:

- · Change in behaviour
- Use of different language e.g. Going Country; Cunch; Trapping; Shots
- Associating with networks
- Signs of assault and/or malnutrition
- Access to numerous phones
- Younger victims also includes: truancy/missing; bus/train tickets; tiredness; new clothing, trainers and cash

## Examples of what we need to know:

- Names of individuals involved and network names if known
- Addresses
- Car registration numbers of those visiting the premises
- Mobile phone numbers of individuals if known
- Types of drugs and weapons involved
