

Summer Passport 2022- Taking Part Guidance

Thank you for registering your child for Gosport Summer Passport. Please check all the information you have submitted is correct, particularly your emergency contact details.

Daily registration

Participants will be required to check in at every session via the Summer Passport registration station on each day. This will be located at various points across each site and staff will be wearing either Motiv8 or Gosport Summer Passport uniform. Participants will be issued with a wristband, so they can take part in activities on offer at that location. Different coloured wristbands are issued each day and all activities are free. There are some activities which have more limited availability but these cannot be booked in advance - queues may occur.

Gosport Summer Passport is an open access scheme and young people are free to leave at any time during the session.

Emergency contact

When your child is attending the event, **please ensure our staff team can contact you or someone you nominate as an emergency contact.** In these situations, the call will be made from a mobile number from one of the Summer Passport staff team and therefore, may not be a number you recognise.

Covid related safety measures

At time of publication, under step 4 of the Government Road map plan, there are no restrictions relating to social distancing and limits on activities taking place, however any relevant guidance will be followed. Our webpage will be kept up to date with the latest information provided by the Government & Public Health England.

Hand sanitising will still be available for those taking part who wish to use it across each location and young people may wish to continue with Lateral Flow testing if they are happy to do so. If a participant feels unwell prior to attending or shows any symptoms, please do not attend the scheme and follow any guidance provided by the NHS – this also includes details of symptoms, testing and when to self-isolate.

Free Bus Travel

A Summer Passport bus pass is available for registered participants and allows free travel on local First bus transport. It is valid only on days that Summer Passport takes place (Tuesday & Thursdays 26/07 – 18/08 inclusive) and can only be used to get to and from Summer Passport locations. We will endeavour to get these posted out to the young person ready for the first activity day, however any bookings after 15th July, please contact **Motiv8 on 02392 525026** to arrange collection.

Driving lessons – Thursday 11th August, Fort Brockhurst

Children aged 14 years and above are eligible to take part in the driving sessions at Fort Brockhurst. A separate consent form needs to be completed for this and will be available on the Motiv8 and Safer Gosport websites nearer the time and from the registration tent from 26/07. Please hand the completed form directly to the driving instructors at Fort Brockhurst to secure a place.

Food, drink and supplies

We advise that your child brings their own food, drink and sunscreen to each session as some locations do not have shops or facilities close by. At some locations, food related activities are included such as a free BBQ or cooking activity but these are not an unlimited supply so may run out before the end of the session depending upon numbers attending. A change of clothes is also advisable for the day at Lee-on-the-Solent on Thursday 28th July, which includes water sports.

Behaviour code

There is a behaviour code in place for young people taking part in the scheme. This is available to view on the Motiv8 and Safer Gosport website and copies are also displayed at each location. Participants choosing not to follow the behaviour code when taking part may be asked to leave or banned from attending further activities.

Activities may be subject to cancellation at short notice and this will be communicated via our social media accounts, website and where possible via email. Regular updates about the scheme and the activities will also be posted across these channels including photos and the details of daily activities.
