



Summer Passport 2024 - Taking Part Guidance

This year's scheme will be operating from 30th July – 22nd August 2024 (Tuesdays and Thursdays) and activities will be available from 11am – 3pm.

Daily registration

Participants will be required to check in at every session via the Summer Passport registration table on each day they attend. This will be located under a gazebo marked 'Registration' and staff will be wearing Gosport Summer Passport or Motiv8 uniform.

Participants will be issued with a wristband, so they can take part in activities on offer at that location. Different coloured wristbands are issued each day and all activities are free. There are some activities which have more limited availability. These cannot be booked in advance - queues may occur.

Gosport Summer Passport is an open access scheme and young people are free to leave at any time during the session.

Emergency contact

When your child is attending the event, **please ensure our staff team can contact you or someone you nominate as an emergency contact.** In these situations, the call will be made from a mobile number from one of the Summer Passport staff team and therefore, may not be a number you recognise.

Free Bus Travel

A Summer Passport bus pass is available for registered participants and allows free travel on local First bus transport. It is valid only on days that Summer Passport takes place (Tuesday & Thursdays 30/07 – 22/08 inclusive) and can only be used to get to and from Summer Passport locations.

Bus passes can be collected from Gosport Borough Council, Town Hall, High Street, PO12 1EB from 15/07/2024 – 29/07/2024 between 09:00 – 17:00. If you are unable to collect your bus pass from the Town Hall you can collect it on your first day of the scheme.

Food, drink and supplies

We advise that your child brings their own food, drink and sunscreen to each session as some locations do not have shops or facilities close by. At some locations, food related activities are included such as a free BBQ or cooking activity but these are not an unlimited supply so may run out before the end of the session depending upon numbers attending.

Behaviour code

There is a behaviour code in place for young people taking part in the scheme. This is available to view on Safer Gosport website and copies will also be displayed at each location. Participants choosing not to follow the behaviour code when taking part may be asked to leave or banned from attending further activities.

Activities may be subject to cancellation at short notice and this will be communicated via our social media account (www.facebook.com/gosportpassportscheme) and website (<https://www.safergosport.co.uk/summer-passport/>).
